Home & School Committees and volunteer opportunities

- > Room Parents help plan classroom parties, organize teacher appreciation week and help in your child's classroom as the teacher needs.
- > SFCP (School, Family, Community, Partnership) Events planned and executed here include: Grandfriend's Day, Parent Principal Night, One Book, One School, Egg Drop, Cultural Kaleidoscope, Highlands outdoor habitat and garden, and featured evening enrichment events.
- > Indoor Recess Games each classroom has a bin of games. Help keep the bins tidy and up to date.
- > Art Awareness go into your child's classroom to introduce a pre-determined artist. Sessions are scheduled at your and the teacher's convenience and are simple and fun.
- > School supply packs work with the teachers to prepare school supply lists and coordinate with vendor.
- > Spirit wear design, and help with the sale of Highlands attire.
- > Book Fair- held during the Spring parent teacher conferences in our LC. Various chances to help.
- Family Connections be part of a database that lends a hand to other Highlands families who may be going through difficult times. Coordinated through the school social worker.
- > Hospitality help with the Ice Cream Social, and meal delivery to school faculty throughout the year.
- > Book Store— every Wednesday from 9:00-10:30am, the book store is set up in the lobby to sell books at cost to students. Volunteers rotate weekly to staff this all year.
- > Rewards program/family night out select and organize Family Night Out restaurant fundraisers throughout the year.
- > Faculty/Staff appreciation we honor our teachers and staff throughout the year on birthdays, and with breakfasts and lunches to show how much we care.
- > Treat Tuesdays- There is a signup the first Tuesday of every month to bring in treats for staff.
- ➤ Vision & Hearing Screening Helper on screening day, escort students to/from screening.
- > Yearbook opportunities for home volunteering as well as in and around the building, including taking pictures and the cover contest.
- > Winter Giving Program Each December, the Highlands community supports and purchases gifts for families in need within our community. Various volunteer opportunities available.
- > Teacher Appreciation Gift Card Program- Coordinate the ordering and distribution of gift cards for teachers and staff during Teacher Appreciation Week.
- > **Fifth Grade projects** Coordinate events deemed unique to fifth graders such as fifth grade yard signs and year-end celebration.
- > Adult Social- help with the planning and set-up of the adult social, one of our big fundraisers for home and school
- > End of year event- Help plan and organize an end of the year all-school celebration for Highlands families.
