 - MTSS: Multi Tiered System of Support
 - Support system put in place to have all students achieve core curriculum, SEL and academic support and interventions
 - On Wednesday mornings teachers are reviewing data to find learning losses that need to be addressed.
 - Missing assignment emails will go to students and parents on Fridays. School will provide content specific tutoring, study halls, and peer tutoring for students. Students that reach a certain threshold of missing assignments or decline in grades will be required to partake in a mandatory study hall to get missing assignments turned in and assistance where needed.
 - 2nd semester will start Huskie Homeroom two times a week on T/Th. Will have a mentor teacher to do a “check in” on the
