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Dear Parents/Guardians:

Open Campus Lunch is a privilege for Seniors and for Juniors that will begin on the first day of school. This privilege allows students to leave campus during their lunch period – and, if they have a **Blended Course**, to leave during that time as well – provided that the teacher has not required them to stay in the building.

Please review the guidelines below with your son/daughter to be sure there are not any misunderstandings about the rules which govern the program. The “opt out” form can be signed by parents who are not giving their children permission to leave campus – either for Open Campus or Blended class time. Contact Student Services for the form.

Students who leave campus must comply with the following guidelines. Students not following these guidelines will be subject to disciplinary consequences that may include immediate revocation of this privilege. Parents may also, at any time, request that the privilege of their child leaving campus be discontinued.

- Students who are late returning from an open campus period will receive discipline consequences and may lose the privilege of leaving campus all together;
- Students must leave within five minutes of when their assigned lunch or Blended period begins and return before the end of that period;
- Students may not spend their assigned lunch or Blended period in vehicles driving on or around the school campus;
- Students are expected to follow all school rules while off campus. They are held accountable to these rules;
- Students are expected to remain in designated areas of the building upon their return from being off-campus;
- Students may choose to remain at school and use school cafeterias or other spaces (i.e. the Learning Commons) to eat or study;
- Students must present their current school ID card to staff upon exiting and entering the building. If a student has forgotten his/her ID, he/she must remain on campus that day. No exceptions;
- Students may not allow other students to use their IDs. Violating this rule is a safety violation and will result in immediate revocation of privileges;
- Students are expected to use designated areas upon exiting and entering the school. These areas are the West End (athletic entrance) and the NPAC (auditorium; rear of the school);
- Students must observe all driving rules and regulations;
- Students may not transport ineligible peers or classmates off-campus. This includes students forgetting to drop current ID, those who have been “opted out,” and those who have been restricted due to disciplinary measures;
- Students may – and will – lose open campus privileges for any discipline issues at school.

As of now, all students have permission to leave during lunch or their Blended class (unless a teacher has required that they stay). If you prefer that this privilege NOT BE EXTENDED to your son or daughter – and you want him or her to REMAIN ON CAMPUS throughout the school day, please complete the attached form.

If you have any questions or wish to opt out of off campus lunch, please contact your son or daughter’s dean.
