VI. Principal's Report

- A. End of the honeymoon period with the students, some behaviors are popping up but (knock on wood) they are all really good kids.
- B. Sports are up and running: girls volleyball, flag football, cross country.
- C. Movie night is October 20th. It will be outdoor but if it does rain it can be moved indoors to the gym.
- D. Parent-Teacher conferences scheduling opened today.
 - a. They will be virtual as Zoom is easier when you have multiple kids and there is more attendance by parents in this format.
- E. Grading system
 - a. There have been some bumps and hiccups with standard based grading on Infinite Campus.
 - i. Formative is practice work (0, 2. 4), counts for 10% of the grade IF the teacher chooses to utilize this category.
 - ii. Summative assignments and summatives assessments (3x the weight of an assignment) account for 90% or 100% of the grade.
 - A problem right now is that summative assignments and summative assessments are weighted the same in the system and they are trying to fix it but until it is fixed teachers are having to manually go in and fix it. The assessment should be weighted 3x that of an assignment.
 - b. A= 3, 3.5 and 4. They are all an A and this is the goal. B= 2.5 2=C 1=D 0=F
 - c. For some assignments there is no option of a 4
 - d. Parent feedback from pilot schools for this grading system was that they want letter grades, not just numbers.
 - e. Official grade will be a letter grade
 - f. A positive to standards based grading is that it provides specifics in a subject that your child excels or needs help with, informs teachers/parents more effectively.
