Periods 1-8 vs Block Schedule

Periods 1-8

- Freshmen attended Huskie Crew one day/week during their lunch period for the first 25 mins (Lessons via Zoom with attendance taken)
- Leader led sessions every week
- Counselor sessions 5 times/Semester 1

Block Schedule

- Asynchronous lessons are posted on Canvas and Remind App (No live sessions with leaders) and freshmen complete on their own. No attendance is taken.
- Leaders check in with their crews biweekly (Zoom, Chat, Meets, Social Media).
- Counselors led a live session via Zoom the week of Oct 26 and will host again the week of Nov 30.
