AP testing announcement

Attention students taking the AP English Lit exam on Wednesday, May 8 and AP English Language exam on Wednesday, May 15 you need to report to your exam by 7:30am even though this is a late start day. If you are a bus rider you will need to find your own transportation to school.

Senior Parking: Class of 2020

The application for Senior Parking Passes is now available. In order to complete the application, you must be logged-in to your student Google account, and each student will be limited to one application submission.

There is one application available, with two options: Carpool and Individual. Please make sure you select the correct option, based on the permit you wish to apply for. **Each student will only be able to complete the Parking Application once.** Please read through all of the application carefully - if you do not meet all the requirements by May 10th, you will not be considered for a Senior Parking pass. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

In order to have a complete application, you must do all of the following:

- **By May 10th (3:00p)**, complete the online [Senior Parking Application](#)
 - You may only submit the parking application ONCE
 - The following information is needed to complete the parking application/survey:
 - Name
 - ID Number
 - E-mail address
 - Vehicle Make/Model (of car that will be driven to NNHS if selected)
 - License Plate # (of car that will be driven to NNHS if selected)
 - *If a Carpool Applicant, same information for Driver #2 will be needed*

By May 17th (3:00p), please submit the following to the Main Office:

- [Parent Signature Form](#) (Print, sign and return)
- Copy of student's driver's license
- Copy of all current insurance cards for listed vehicles
- DO NOT SEND MONEY

If the online application is not completed by May 10th **AND** all required paperwork is not turned in by May 17th, the entire application will be denied. Please paperclip all materials together (do NOT staple your paperwork). Do not submit any money at this time. You will be contacted (via student email) on Wednesday, August 7th, letting you know if you will be granted a Senior Parking pass. If you are granted a parking pass, on Thursday, August 8th at Senior Registration, you will need to bring your \$100 check made out to NCUSD203.

There will be over 700 upcoming seniors, and there are 350 parking passes. If every senior applies for an Individual Parking Pass, then you will have less than a 50% chance of receiving a pass. However, if you apply as a Carpool, your odds increase to 100%.

Please remember that parking is a privilege and it is NOT GUARANTEED. Unfortunately, special circumstances (job, sport, family needs, medical needs, etc) will not factor into parking pass decisions. Ultimately all carpool applications will be granted a pass; any additional available passes will be decided by a lottery.

Registration at Naperville North will have two required parts:

Part 1- Complete the Online Annual Update in the [Infinite Campus Parent Portal account](#) before May 3, 2019. This online update will replace much of the paperwork that was previously sent home. This annual update is required for all returning students.

Part 2- Students attend Registration at Naperville North in August. This process will look much like it has in the past for students with the advantage of paperwork being completed online in advance. Students will receive Chromebooks, textbooks, handbooks, school ID, locker assignment, and schedule of classes. Please mark your calendar for the following dates of Registration:

- Monday, August 5 – Freshman Registration
- Tuesday, August 6 – Sophomore Registration (Freshmen may attend)
- Wednesday, August 7 – Junior Registration (Freshmen & Sophomores may attend)
- Thursday, August 8 – Senior Registration (All students may attend)

Please note: Students may attend any day after their scheduled registration day. Students who are not able to attend during registration week, will be able to attend Late Registration on Wednesday, August 14.
