

A Student's Guide to NNHS Free/Reduced Lunch and Waiver Information



GENERAL INFORMATION

LUNCH: Students who are eligible for the Free or Reduced lunch program must choose a combo lunch. In order to comply with USDA regulations, students must take an entrée, a fruit and/or vegetable as part of the combo meal. Milk or juice is included but optional. Students who are on the Reduced Lunch program pay 30¢ for breakfast and 40¢ for Lunch. (This price is subject to change).

SCHOOL FEES: Students who qualify for the Free or Reduced lunch program are entitled to a waiver of curricular fees. This includes all course fees, concert attire and drivers' education. Please note that curricular fees **do not include** school supplies, library and equipment fines, replacement costs for textbooks or library books, class rings, yearbooks, pictures, admission charges for dances, athletic events or other social events.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: One PE t-shirt and one PE lock will be provided free of charge. Additional items may be purchased in the School Store at regular cost.

FIELD TRIPS: All curricular field trips are covered; a voucher must be obtained from **Nandini Asar**, Financial Secretary in the Main Office. All BSLA and LASA field trips that occur during the school day are covered.

SENIOR EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES

Senior year is a time for special events and activities. Families, who qualify for federal assistance through the national school lunch program (free/reduced lunch), are able to receive some additional benefits for senior students through the generosity of some of our vendors and school-based assistance plans. Because some events have a cost associated with them and some items are purchased from outside vendors, price reductions are not possible for everything. To assist families in planning, the following have been put into place:

SENIOR YEARBOOK PHOTO (Free) – LIFETOUCH: This is available to ALL students. Photo sessions are done during the summer months. You can reach LIFETOUCH at 630-910-6800 to schedule a yearbook photo session/retake for Naperville North. **LAST DAY** sessions will be Wednesday, September 26, 2024. **Photos from other sources WILL NOT be allowed/used.**

COLLEGE APPLICATION FEES: Students who qualify for Free/Reduced lunch are also eligible for fee waivers for their college applications. Please see your **school counselor** in Student Services for more information.

SENIOR CELEBRATION: This optional event will be held on Saturday, April 12, 2025 and is a celebration for seniors only! The price is \$50 before December 1, 2024. Price increases to \$60 from December 2, 2024 until April 12, 2025.

FREE CAP/GOWN/MEDAL & TASSEL: The student/parent is responsible for contacting Student Activities to have this verified and to get the information needed to order the cap & gown. **You must contact the Student Activities Office after October 15, 2024. Please complete this task ASAP. If contacted later than January 15, 2025 your attire may not be available for pickup on Senior Day.**

SENIOR EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES

Senior Assembly: This is on Cap & Gown Distribution Day on February 21, 2025.

Exit with Pride: this free event is held at Centennial Beach on May 15, 2025 from Noon – 2:00pm.

Participation in Commencement Ceremony: There is a mandatory rehearsal on May 16, 2025 at 7:00 am in the Fieldhouse.



ELECTIVE ITEMS

The following items are optional and **are not** covered by the free/reduced lunch waivers. All events subject to change without notice.

Senior Brunch: This is held the Friday before Graduation. Price is \$50 at Registration. Price increases thereafter. Last day to register and pay is May 2, 2025.

Senior Ad in the Yearbook: Please visit www.theyearbookcompany.com to place your order; it includes a note from parents & a personal "baby" picture of your senior. **Prices increase each month on the 16th beginning in October. Final Deadline January 16, 2025**

Yearbook: Cost is \$50 prior to January 1, 2025. Price increases to \$65 thereafter. Must be purchased by June 1, 2025.

Prom: May 3, 2025. Estimated ticket price is \$90. Price will increase. See additional details published in March with year-end information.
