Willing Spirits: Volunteers will be called upon throughout the year for short-term projects on an as-needed basis.

Student Registration: Over 200 volunteers assist students in the registration process. Shifts available am/pm or both August 12th-13th, 2021.

Dances: Decorate, check-in/check-out students, set up/serve/clean up refreshments. Variety of morning & evening shifts available for both Homecoming, October 16th, 2021, and Spring Dance, March 3, 2022.

Senior Celebration: NNHS parents throw the party of the year on April 9, 2022! Over 300 parents are needed to make this amazing event happen before and on that date. Many opportunities available - check-in, decorations, gather prizes, assemble photos collages, help in the kitchen, park cars, or even chaperone the event!
