Online Annual Update: All families will be required to update their student's information through their Campus Parent Account. The Online Annual Update for returning families must be completed by May 31, 2021. If you do not complete your update by May 31, 2021 you will be required to complete the Online Annual Update **AND** provide proof of residency in order for your student(s) to attend a Naperville 203 school for the 2021-2022 school year. The following information will assist you in completing each of your student's Annual Update for the 2021-2022 school year:

- To access the Online Annual Update, you will need your Campus Parent username and password. If you do not have a Campus Parent Account, contact *Parent Support* at parentsupport@naperville203.org.

If your Online Annual Update reflects a change of address, proof of residency at your new address must be provided. If there is a change in the family structure *i.e. divorce*, a Parenting/Custody Agreement must be provided for these changes/updates to take effect. Documents may be uploaded for review while completing your Online Update, emailed to Enrollment203edocs@naperville203.org or they may be brought into our Centralized Enrollment Office. Hey Seniors! Saturday, May 1st, is College Decision Day. By May 1, you need to make sure you tell the college/university to plan to attend that you are committing to them for the fall. You also need to let the other schools you applied to know that you will not be attending. In addition, there are two more steps we need you to take, to make sure we can get your final high school transcript to your college/university. The steps below are not optional, and should only take a few minutes to complete. Complete the Senior Exit Survey (<https://forms.gle/WaNzoiVXKQTg7h8U7>): Once you know where you'll be attending, we need you to complete the Senior Exit survey. This helps us know where your final transcript will be going & will be used to help us create the Senior Map for Senior Celebration! Fill Out & Turn in the Final Transcript Authorization (<https://www.naperville203.org/FinalTranscript>): This form gives NNHS permission to send your Final Transcript to the college/university you'll be attending. Please fill it out (make sure to sign it, too) and return it to our

Student Vaccines: We are pleased to announce that District 203 and District 204 have collaborated with Jewel/Osco pharmacy to host a COVID-19 vaccine clinic from 8 am to 6 pm on Saturday, May 22 at Neuqua Valley High School located at 2360 95th St, Naperville. The purpose of the clinic is to make this opportunity available to our students ages 16 and up. Jewel/Osco pharmacists will be administering the Pfizer vaccine, which requires two doses. Students must be available on June 12 to receive the second dose. If a student cannot make both dates, do not schedule an appointment. Students aged 16-17 are required to have a parent/guardian complete a consent form prior to coming onsite that day. Students must also bring a form of identification. Prior to completing the application, students will be asked to create an account with Submittable, the platform utilized for collecting applications, by providing their name, a username and email address. The SAC, which was established in 1975, represents a diverse group of young leaders from across the state who have demonstrated the ability to advocate for educational equity on the behalf of all Illinois public school students. SAC members are passionate about creating impactful change through educational legislation, policies, and rules. Each year the SAC identifies areas of focus and collaborates with educational leaders in order to provide the Board of Education with recommendations on how to rethink and enhance current initiatives.
