If your Online Annual Update reflects a change of address, proof of residency at your new address must be provided. If there is a change in the family structure *i.e. divorce*, a Parenting/Custody Agreement must be provided for these changes/updates to take effect. SAC members are passionate about creating impactful change through educational legislation, policies, and rules.
