ASVAB 2021: TEST DATES: OCTOBER 30th OR NOVEMBER 6th, 2021

Naperville Central and Naperville North will offer the ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) Career Exploration Assessment for Sophomore, Junior and Senior students. Naperville Central will host on Saturday, October 30th, and Naperville North will host on Saturday, November 6th. The ASVAB is a standardized exam and will take approximately 3 hours to complete. On either date, the testing will begin at 8 a.m., and there is no charge to take it. Students may schedule to test at either location; however, registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis with limited seats at each site.

The ASVAB results are used when a student enters the military, however, students do NOT need to have an interest in the military to take the assessment. The ASVAB helps students to accurately identify their strengths with the Interest Inventory Skills section. ASVAB results also give students a current snapshot of their skill levels so they may improve performance on high-stakes standardized tests. The ASVAB results will not be released to recruiting services unless you complete an Opt-in letter. Please see your school's contact for a copy of the letter.

ON TEST DAY: Students will need to report to school between 7:30 and 7:45 a.m. They should bring their Chromebook and a picture I.D. (required). Food/drinks are not permitted in the testing area. Cell phones and other electronic devices need to be powered off and put away. Testing should be completed at approximately 11:00 a.m.

Emergency/E-Learning Days: Beginning this school year, District 203 could choose to utilize eLearning days instead of emergency days (typically caused by winter storms and other conditions that make it unsafe to travel to or stay at school). e-Learning days will allow students to learn virtually instead of having to cancel school and extend the school year. However, at times there may still be a need to use emergency days without e-Learning if an emergency happens with little warning and/or there is not enough time to activate the e-Learning plan. Whichever plan is activated, our families will be notified via email, phone call and the Remind app.

If we have an eLearning day, students and families will be notified early that no emergency day will be used and students will need to log in to all their Canvas courses by 9 am and complete asynchronous learning and work. This notification will go out via all-call, email, social media and my NNHS principal's Remind. If you have not signed up for this Remind there is still time. TEXT @nnhspr to 81010. You can expect 5 hours of asynchronous learning which includes homework. There will not be any live, synchronous instruction on eLearning days. Your teachers will be available to support you or answer questions between 9am and 2pm. If you are unable to participate in eLearning, a parent/guardian must report you absent via the school attendance line.

Free ECG Screening: Naperville North High School is partnering with The Young Hearts for Life (YH4L) Cardiac Screening Program, a not for profit organization, to offer electrocardiograms (ECGs) to our students on *Thursday, October 28, 2021*. This painless, non-invasive screening is FREE to students thanks to the generosity of Edward-Elmhurst Health. In March 2020, 11 abnormal ECGs were detected, and 1,920 NNHS students were screened.

Register your student now for this FREE screening by visiting [Young Hearts for Life](#). Scroll to the bottom and click "I am giving permission for my child." You will then be taken to a page that allows you to complete the registration process. All testing occurs during your student's PE or Health Class time.

Each week, sudden cardiac death claims the lives of more than 60 young adults in the United States. Early identification is key to saving lives. A sports physical will only detect 4% of students at risk for Sudden Cardiac Death (SCD). An ECG can detect 70% of students at risk.

HELP NEEDED: Help save a life! We rely on approximately 120 volunteers to make this event a success. Volunteers do not need to have medical experience. Unless recently trained, volunteers are required to attend a brief training program during the evening on Wednesday, October 27th at NNHS.
