The Lincoln staff is excited to welcome our students to the 2023-24 school year, and they are busy making plans to ensure a smooth transition back. This letter shares some essential details to assist you in the registration process. We will continue to communicate throughout the summer to keep you apprised of any changes. Please review this information carefully and don't hesitate to call the school at 630-420-6370 if you have any questions.

The school year officially begins on Thursday, August 17th, 2023, with transportation and food services. Our school day runs from 8:00 a.m. to 2:50 p.m. Transportation information can be accessed in the Campus Portal (<http://www.Naperville203.org>) starting on August 7th at 3:00 p.m. Please check back frequently leading up to the start of school since changes can occur in routes and pick-up times. If you need assistance regarding transportation information, call the Transportation Department at 630-420-6464. If you drive your child to school, please be aware of the drop-off protocols and follow the direction of the staff that is there to assist you.

Schedules will be available in the Infinite Campus Portal on August 7th after 3:00 p.m. Please print your child's schedule with the locker combination and bring it with you to Locker Jam. When printing the schedule, please ensure you select "**schedule with locker and combo**". You will not be able to view the locker combinations on your cell phone, so a printed copy of the schedule is required. Anyone without the ability to print their schedule can get assistance through the school's office.

Our WEB staff is planning our 6th-grade orientation program, Where Everybody Belongs (WEB), scheduled for Wednesday, August 9th. The program is scheduled to begin at 3 pm with bus transportation starting at 2:30 pm for students who are normally scheduled to ride the bus. A parent orientation will begin at 6:00 pm in the Wood Gym.

A SCHOOL FEES STATEMENT has been included in this mailing. We are requesting that fees be paid by August 1, 2023. Please complete the accompanying fee sheet and return it to Lincoln Junior High School, 1320 S. Olympus Drive, Naperville, Illinois 60565. All checks should be made payable to School District 203. 
