Committee Chair Positions 2023-2024

Back to School Bash – Games – Work with game vendor, map game locations, update game rules and prize redemption, work with volunteer coordinator for vol needs, setup/takedown

Back to School Bash – Marketing – Plan w principal & exec board, promote B2SB at summer/school events and across media communications, signage, work with volunteer coordinator

Benefits –Plan and partner with local restaurants for our monthly restaurant benefit nights. Not only do these benefit nights give our families a much welcomed night off from cooking, they also raise money for our school.

Communications – Help facilitate communications between Steeple Run, Home&School, and families by - updating weekly newsletters for Home & School activities, post to FB/other media sites

Diversity - Celebrates the diversity within our Steeple Run community by developing programming for special heritage/history months such as Hispanic Heritage, Native American Heritage, African American Heritage, Women’s History, Asian Pacific Islander Heritage and more!!

Fifth Grade Activities (one parent per 5th grade classroom) - Plans and runs activities for the fifth graders, which includes a party for the students at the end of the year. This committee also coordinates the design and sale of the fifth grade class T-shirts.

Fun Run (Coordinator) - Coordination of the fun run activities

Fun Run (Sponsorship) - Solicit local business owners to sponsor our fun run t-shirts.

Great Kindness Challenge -Plans and coordinates school-wide activities for The Great Kindness Challenge alongside Student Council, which is a week-long event in January that encourages students to create a culture of kindness.

Holiday Shop - Plans and staffs the annual Holiday Shop, which is held in early December and allows students to do holiday shopping for friends and family in a fun, festive environment.

Organizer - Reorganizes Home & School Closet pre/post parties and files.

Room Parents - Will serve as a communication liaison between Home & School and the parents in their student's classroom. In addition they will organize and execute the Fall, Winter, and Friendship parties with the other Room Parents in their grade.

Room Photographers - Takes photos through the year at parties and events. Gets to know all students to provide inclusion and variety for the yearbook.

School Family Community Partnership (SFCP) - Enhances children's learning by strengthening the partnership that exists between parents, school staff and the community. The committee develops programs and events that foster the achievement of Steeple Run's school enhancement goals. Past events include Literacy Night, Math Night, Movie Night, World Performance Night and International Festival.
