

**SENIOR STUDENT PARKING
RULES & REGULATIONS
2015-2016**

STUDENTS

You are responsible for everything contained in this letter. Please read carefully prior to the first day of school and prior to parking on school grounds.

PARKING LOCATIONS

West Lot (athletics); Tennis Courts; Auditorium Lot "Blue Lot" (last TWO rows ONLY)

BASIC RULES

1. You must have a valid driver's license and be insured. All documentation must be turned into and updated frequently with Mr. Madden in SS2.
2. **Only seniors who have been issued parking passes are allowed to park in the lot.**
3. Changes in vehicles must be reported to Mrs. Calzaretta/Mrs. Donnary in the SS2 office.
4. No motorcycles.
5. Tags must be displayed at all times and cannot be obstructed.
6. If you forget your tag, you must park off-campus. Going to your dean for "special permission" is not acceptable.
7. If you lose your tag, a **\$35** replacement charge will be assessed. We can replace your tag ONE time; if you lose or misplace it again, you will forfeit parking privileges.
8. Parking in the lot using an invalid, forged, or scanned tag will result in suspension from school, and your car will be towed. If you use a parking pass that was assigned to another student, you will face disciplinary consequences.
9. Likewise, if you provide your tag to another student so that he/she can "copy" it, you will be suspended from school, and your parking privileges will be revoked.
10. Loaning or giving your tag to someone else is not allowed.
11. NNHS reserves the right to search your vehicle at any given time.
12. If you lose your parking privileges for any reason, your money will not be refunded.
13. In order to maintain parking privileges, you must refrain from the following: truancy, constant lateness to school or when returning from open campus lunch, driving recklessly or speeding, parking in areas that are not designated for student use, continued disciplinary referrals, etc. Your dean is the final say as to whether your parking privileges remain current, are suspended, or are revoked.
14. Students must follow all the laws with regard to the number of young people in vehicle.
15. Smoking and loud music are not permitted on campus.
16. Once seniors graduate, car tags assigned to them are invalid.
17. Do NOT park in unauthorized locations such as visitor, staff, or reserved spots.
18. Temporary parking will not be provided to anybody for any reason. We do not have the space.
19. Most importantly, parking on campus is privilege that most seniors covet. Please respect this privilege.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN A LOSS OF PARKING PRIVILEGES AND THE POSSIBILITY OF YOUR VEHICLE BEING TOWED.
