UIC: The University of Illinois at Chicago offers talented high school seniors the opportunity to apply for guaranteed admission into many professional and graduate programs including Medicine, Pharmacy, Dentistry, Nursing, PT, OT and Law, to name a few. Seniors would apply through the UIC Guaranteed Professional Program Admissions (GPPA). The deadline for all GPPA programs is January 15th except GPPA-Medicine which is December 1st.

Truman State: Entry into A.T. Still College of Osteopathic Medicine during sophomore year.

SLU: St. Louis University offers 98% admission rate from SLU pre-med to SLU medical school. Students are still required to take the MCATS. However, MCATS are not weighted in graduate admission decisions. Ideally, students should have a 30 on the ACT and A's in math and science courses to be successful at this program. Academic success in the SLU pre-med program is heavily weighted in the graduate admission decision.

Washington University in St. Louis offers the University Scholars Program in Medicine that holds a place in the entering class of the Medical school after a successful completion of Undergraduate studies. Students still have to take the MCATs and maintain a certain GPA.

The University of Missouri Kansas City has a 6-year medical program

St. Bonaventure University in NY has an automatic entry program set up with George Washington University medical school.

The University of Akron is part of consortium here in Northeast Ohio with the Northeastern Ohio Universities College of Medicine (NEOUCOM) called the B.S./M.D. program. This program allows students to gain a seat in medical school directly from high school.
